## 23 - 24 Overview

### We boosted approx. 260 Saratoga students this year (180 @SHS & 80 @SUSD)

#### **Highlights**

- RMS Drama Club really took off with 55 members!
- Drama Club at Saratoga Elementary school running
- Drama coaches & club curriculum provided for SUSD
- Built highly productive partnership with Ms Villela's digital photography class
- Developed new relationship with West Valley College
   Performing Arts team
- Funded first time grant for SHS English Dept
   Shakespeare workshops (120 students)
- Moved to **Smugmug** site for photo galleries
- Introduced formal grant application process
- Built our newsletter audience to 480+ subscribers

#### Lowlights

Donations were significantly down:
 \$25k from 59 people this year vs \$54k from

97 people in 22-23

- Fewer students than we expected at SHS:
  - Almost, Maine: 41 vs 55 (50 for The Crucible in '22)
  - Something Rotten: 34 vs 68 (58 for Mamma Mia! in '23)
- 4 STA board seats went unfilled with 2 officers covering multiple areas
